





Sacred Journey

FOCUS

This introductory program will include overview material on the areas of principles of spirituality, Christian spirituality and prayer, Ignatian Spirituality, vocation and discernment of call, spirituality and social justice, spirituality and personal maturity and integration.

FORMAT

Nine monthly presentations by experienced Mercy Center staff and acclaimed guest presenters from September through May, small group process, interactive exercises, assigned texts and other reading, and reflection papers.
